Payment: Payment must be included. Accepting all Checks and Credit Cards or PayPal on our website. Make checks payable to: The Garden Club at Palm Coast, 75 Island Estates Pkwy, Palm Coast FL 32137. This is an indoor/outdoor rain or shine event, there will be no refunds due to weather or for no-shows.

Set-Up & Break Down: Set-Up is Friday afternoon for vendors from 3:00 PM to 7:00 PM (Garden club volunteers ONLY are permitted between 1:00 PM and 3:00 PM) and Saturday from 7:00 AM to 8:45 AM. All vehicles must be removed from the event area by 9:00 AM. Vendor parking will be provided on site. Break-Down is Saturday at 4:00 PM and you must keep your booth set-up till then unless directed otherwise by the event chair.

Suitability: The Garden Club at Palm Coast reserves the right to decline what they deem may not be appropriate or suitable to display or sell. Vendors, please remember that this is a family event.

Sales Tax: All vendors are responsible for collecting 7% sales tax and reporting to the Florida Department of Revenue on all applicable sales and must have a Business Tax Receipt Permit. Community non-profit organizations must submit a copy of their 501(c)(3) certificate. Please attach a copy of your Insurance Certificate.

Liability: The owner or custodian of property of any kind brought to the grounds either for exhibit or for sale, or for any other purpose assumes, as a condition of admission to the grounds, all risk and/or responsibility for its loss, damage or theft. The Garden Club at Palm Coast, Flagler County Schools and the City of Palm Coast cannot and will not accept responsibility and liability for any damage or injury resulting from theft, fire, the elements, accidents, or any other conditions or causes, whether to exhibits, property of exhibitors and/or vendors, vehicles on the grounds and articles left therein and any other property of any nature whatsoever.
